the Department of Defense may waive any General Sched-2 ule qualification standard related to work experience es-3 tablished by the Director of the Office of Personnel Man-4 agement in the case of any applicant for a nursing or prac-5 tical nurse position in a medical treatment facility or other health care facility the Department of Defense who— 6 7 (1)(A) is a nurse or practical nurse in the De-8 partment of Defense; or 9 (B) was a nurse or practical nurse in the De-10 partment of Defense for at least 1 year; and 11 (2) after commencing work as a nurse or prac-12 tical nurse in the Department of Defense, obtained 13 a Bachelor's degree or graduate degree from an ac-14 credited professional nursing educational program. 15 (b) CERTIFICATION.—If, in the case of any applicant described in subsection (a), a hiring manager waives a 16 17 qualification standard in accordance with such subsection, such hiring manager shall submit to the Director of the 18 19 Office of Personnel Management a certification that such 20 applicant meets all remaining General Schedule qualifica-21 tion standards established by the Director of the Office 22 of Personnel Management for the applicable position.
