2	Section 161 of the Energy Policy and Conservation
3	Act (42 U.S.C. 6241) is amended by adding at the end

6	"(1) WITHDRAWAL BY THE PRESIDENT.—
7	"(A) In General.—Notwithstanding sub-

6	"(2) Withdrawal by statute.—For pur-
7	poses of paragraph (1), a withdrawal of land from
8	oil and gas leasing provided by an Act of Congress
9	shall not be considered a withdrawal by the Presi-
10	dent.
11	"(3) Exception.—Paragraph (1) shall not
12	apply with respect to a drawdown and sale that is
13	required by a severe energy supply interruption that,
14	as determined by the Secretary, was caused by—
15	"(A) an act of sabotage;
16	"(B) an act of war;
17	"(C) an act of terrorism; or
18	"(D) an act of God.".
